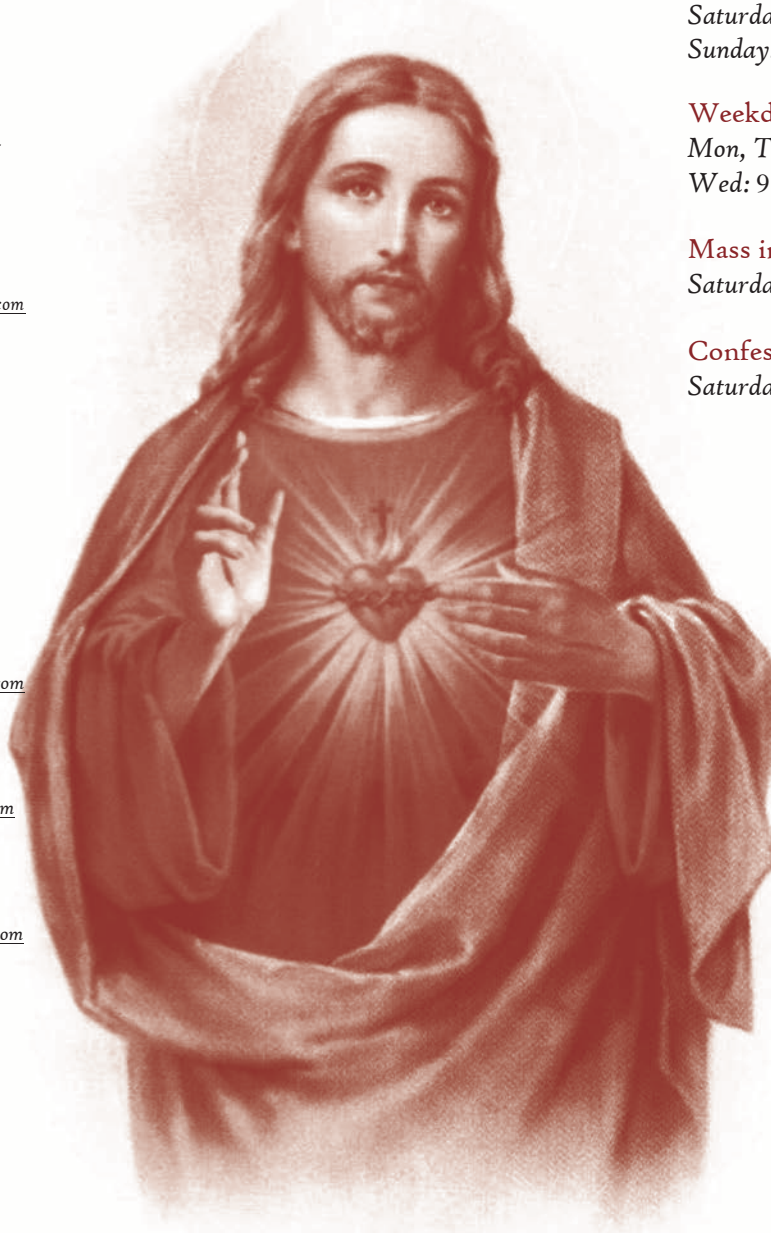

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, I will be accompanying 35 college students from our parish and the greater Dayton area to Seek 2015 in Nashville, Tennessee. Seek 2015 is the national conference hosted by the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). We will join over 9,000 college students from across the nation in prayer, repentance, relevant talks, panel discussions, entertainment and a full night life in the music capital of the world. FOCUS was started by Curtis Martin, a layman who had an uneven college experience. As a business professional, he felt inspired by God to use his faith and marketing skills to assist our youth in their most serious need: spiritual direction. Right now, Curtis Martin and an entire staff of professionals and priests train recent college graduates to bring college students into a place of committed discipleship. This faith enables the college students to be saved, to enter right relationships, and to become the professionals our families, the Church, and our nation so desperately need. Currently there are over 300 FOCUS missionaries on over 70 campuses in the US. The most local FOCUS missionary team is on location at Wright State University. This weekend, I will be hearing confessions, offering spiritual direction, and encouraging the students in their full human development. Please pray for us.


