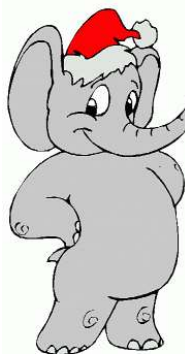
At the Manager — And Animals Were There
