Dear Parishioners,

As we rejoice in Christmas and the year comes to a close, I am especially grateful for many graces in our parish. The first is the refinancing of our loan. I am proud of the way our finance council has been steering our parish's finances and landed a better interest rate which will free up about \$800 per month. With our tight budget and with volunteers doing what paid staff was formerly doing, this savings will go a long way.

Secondly, we had a robust year for youth ministry. Steven Hughes, our youth leader, recently reported to duty in the Air Force and we had to replace him. It took two people. Hollie is especially interested in women's and young women's ministry, theology of the body and building vibrant catechetical engaging youth ministry programs that lead teens closer to Christ.*
