

 *From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear Parishioners,

Our parish council and Mary Help of Christians had our first planning meeting. We met this past Tuesday evening. The purpose of the meeting was to work out how two parishes can share one pastor.

We discussed what a typical weekend Mass schedule might look like. Perhaps on Saturday we can do a 4:00 p.m. at one parish and a 6:00 p.m. at the other parish, with some time for confessions at each place. We also discussed the fact that on Saturday evenings we have a Spanish Mass at 7:00 p.m. on the second and fourth Saturdays of the month. Fr. Gonzales is 75 and will be retiring back to his home in Columbia this summer. We are hoping to replace him with a native speaking Spanish priest. If we cannot, we will re-think the entire Saturday schedule. On Sunday morning, each parish will probably have one Mass, either at 9:00 a.m. or 11:30 a.m.

We discussed whether we could have joint confirmations or any other apostolic activities in common.

We will continue to meet with Mary Help of Christians and keep you informed of our progress in the formation of the Sacred Heart – Mary Help of Christians Pastoral Region.
