



From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Our newly erected Parish Council met for the first time on February 1. The ex-officio members are Matt Prenatt of Buildings and Grounds, Abby Wilson, Catechism; Dave Leapley, Worship Commission; Ed Sherman, Community Outreach and Socials. We discussed the following topics:

- The need to register our Latino parishioners, to care for their needs and to find ways to give them more ownership in the parish. For example, to have representation on the parish council. Also, they would very much like a statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe in the sanctuary.
- Strategic planning to form our Pastoral Region, which basically means working with Mary Help of Christians to work out a Mass schedule which will allow one priest to cover all the Masses at both parishes beginning July of 2015.
- The need for a solution for the overcrowded parking lot when catechism gets out and the 11:30 Mass begins.
- The need for four more people on the parish council so that we will have four ex-officio and four at-large members voted on by the parish. Nominations for new members will be taken in Mass the weekend of March 16 and elections will be the weekend of April 6.
- The tiles on the hallway of the top floor of the parish hall are loose, becoming hazardous and need replaced.

I am very impressed with our parishioners who are taking initiative and renewing and rebuilding Sacred Heart Parish.

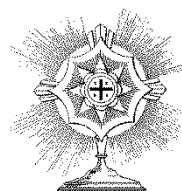
Have you made your reservations for the Old-fashioned Dinner Parish Social?
