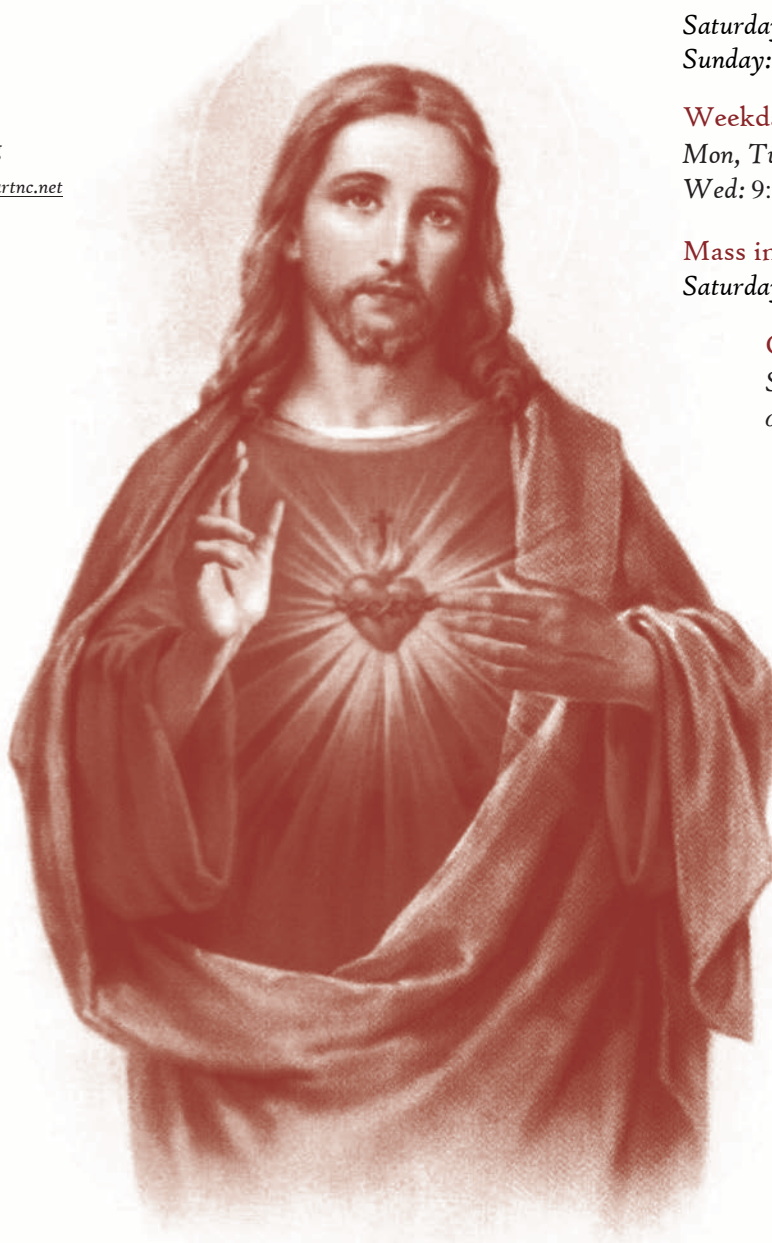

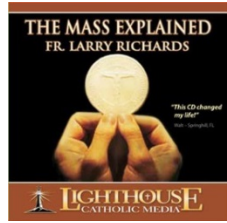

Let us pray for the children and their families and recall in our own hearts what a special gift receiving Jesus **truly** is in our life!



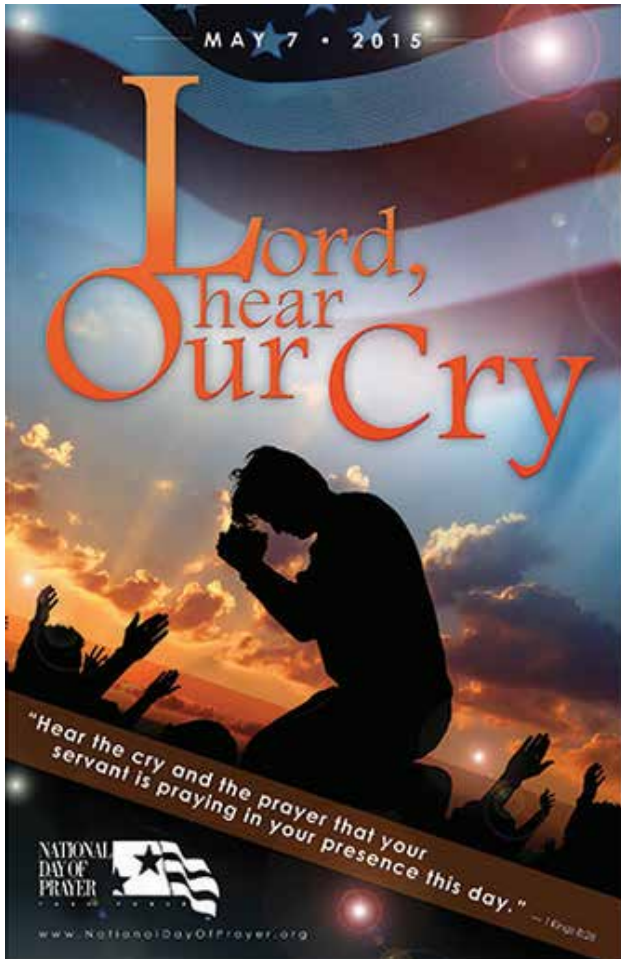

## **El Sacramento de la Eucaristía**



La Eucaristía es la consagración del pan en el Cuerpo de Cristo y del vino en su Sangre, renueva mística y sacramentalmente el sacrificio de Jesucristo en la Cruz.

Por otra parte, la recepción de Jesucristo sacramentado bajo las especies de pan y vino en la sagrada Comunión significa y verifica el alimento espiritual del alma. Y así, en cuanto que en ella se da la gracia invisible bajo especies visibles, guarda razón de sacramento.

Tiene razón de sacrificio en cuanto se ofrece, y de sacramento en cuanto se recibe.

La Eucaristía es el sacramento en el cual, bajo las especies de pan y vino, Jesucristo se halla verdadera, real y substancialmente presente, con su cuerpo, su sangre, su alma y su divinidad.

Es por eso, el más grande e importante de los sacramentos, de donde salen y hacia el que van todos los demás, centro de la vida litúrgica, expresión y alimento de la comunión cristiana.

La Eucaristía fue también preanunciada varias veces en el Antiguo Testamento.

- Solomón en el libro de los Proverbios: "La Sabiduría se edificó una casa con siete columnas (los siete sacramentos), preparó una mesa y envió a sus criados a decir: " Venid, comed el pan y bebed el vino que os he preparado". (Prov. 9,1).
- El profeta Malaquías, hablando de las impurezas de los sacrificios de la ley: "Desde donde sale el sol hasta el ocaso, grande es mi nombre entre las gentes, y en todo lugar se sacrifica y ofrece a mi nombre una oblación pura" (Mal. 1,10ss).

La verdad de la presencia real, corporal y substancia de Jesús en la Eucaristía, fue profetizada por el mismo Señor antes de instituir la, durante el discurso que pronunció en la Sinagoga de Cafarnaúm, al día siguiente de haber hecho el milagro de la multiplicación de los panes y de los peces. "Yo soy el pan de la vida, si uno come de este pan vivirá para siempre, pues el pan que yo os daré es mi carne, para la vida del mundo" (Jn.6,32-34, 51).

El signo externo del sacramento, son la materia (pan y vino) y las palabras de la consagración (forma). Confiere la gracia, como afirma el mismo Cristo: "El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna". (Jn 6,54), o sea, la gracia, que es prenda de vida eterna.

Fue instituido por Jesucristo en la Última Cena, como consta repetidamente en la escritura: "Mientras comían, Jesús tomó pan, lo bendijo, lo partió y dándoselo a los discípulos, dijo: "Tomad y comed, esto ES mi cuerpo". Y tomando el cáliz y dando gracias, se lo dio, diciendo: "Bebed de el todos, que esta ES mi sangre del Nuevo Testamento; que será derramada por muchos para remisión de los pecados". (Mt.26,26-28).

La materia para la confección de la Eucaristía es el pan de trigo y el vino de la vid. Esta es una verdad de fe definida en el Concilio de Trento.

Lo que se realiza, pues, en la Eucaristía es la conversión del pan y del vino en el Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, que es lo que llamamos la transubstanciación.

Bajo cada una de las especies sacramentales (pan y vino), y bajo cada una de sus partes cuando se fraccionan, está contenido Jesucristo entero, con su Cuerpo, su Sangre, su Alma y su Divinidad.


