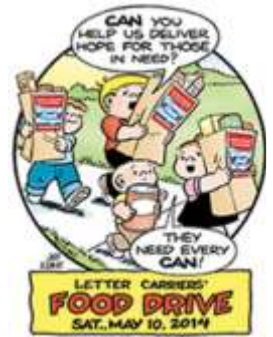
**Mother's Day Flowers**
