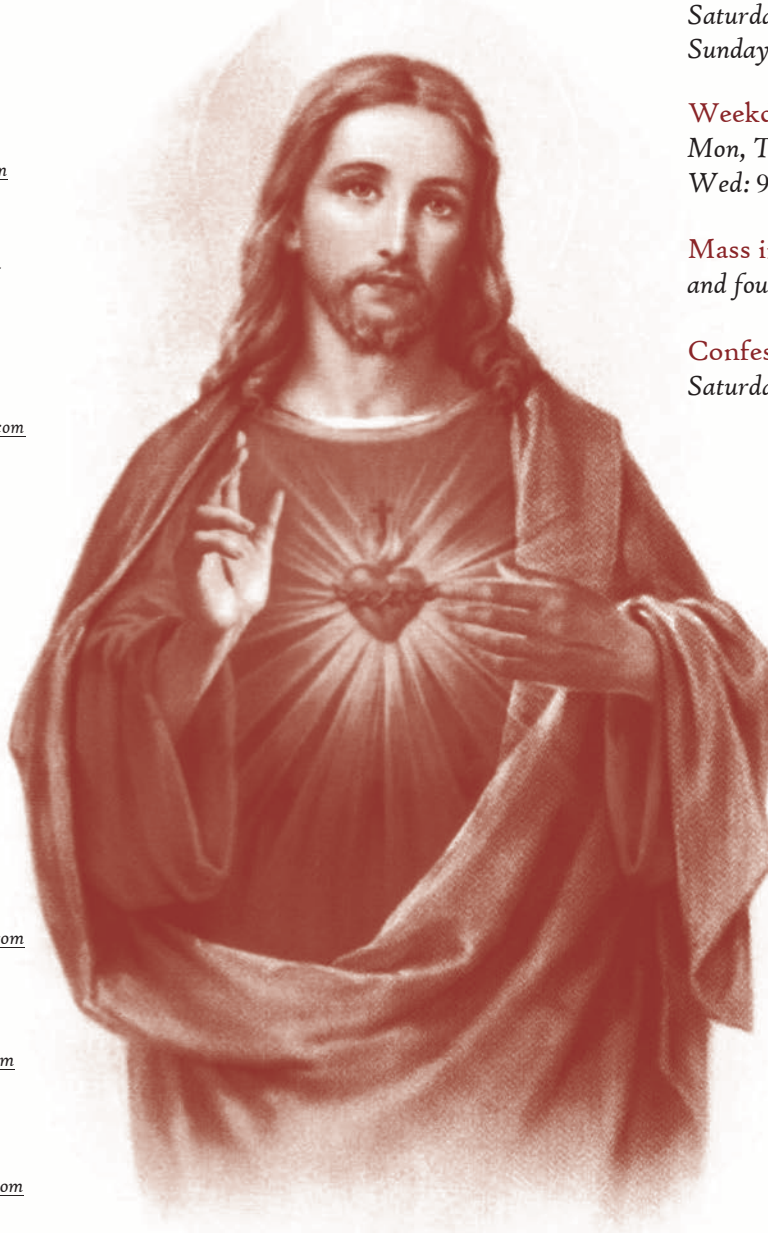

 *From the Pastor's Desk*

Dear Parishioners,

This week the Supreme Court issued a 5-4 ruling in favor of the Hobby Lobby and Conestoga Wood Specialties lawsuits against the mandate handed down by the federal Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) requiring all employers to offer insurance coverage of abortion-inducing drugs, contraceptives, and sterilizations. I am greatly relieved that our highest court recognizes and affirms the importance of religious freedom in the practice of business. Hobby Lobby and Conestoga Wood Specialties have won an important victory regarding religious conscience. I hope this is a triumph for our numerous Catholic institutions that are pursuing similar lawsuits.

All of these cases challenge the federal mandate requiring insurance coverage of such objectionable services as abortion-inducing drugs, contraceptives and sterilizations. But the issue at hand goes far beyond birth control, which today's ruling addresses. The issue strikes at the heart of the first 16 words of the First Amendment: "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof. ..." This weekend, as we continue to celebrate the Fourth of July we should also be grateful for this recent court decision. This decision affirms America's first freedom—religious freedom.


